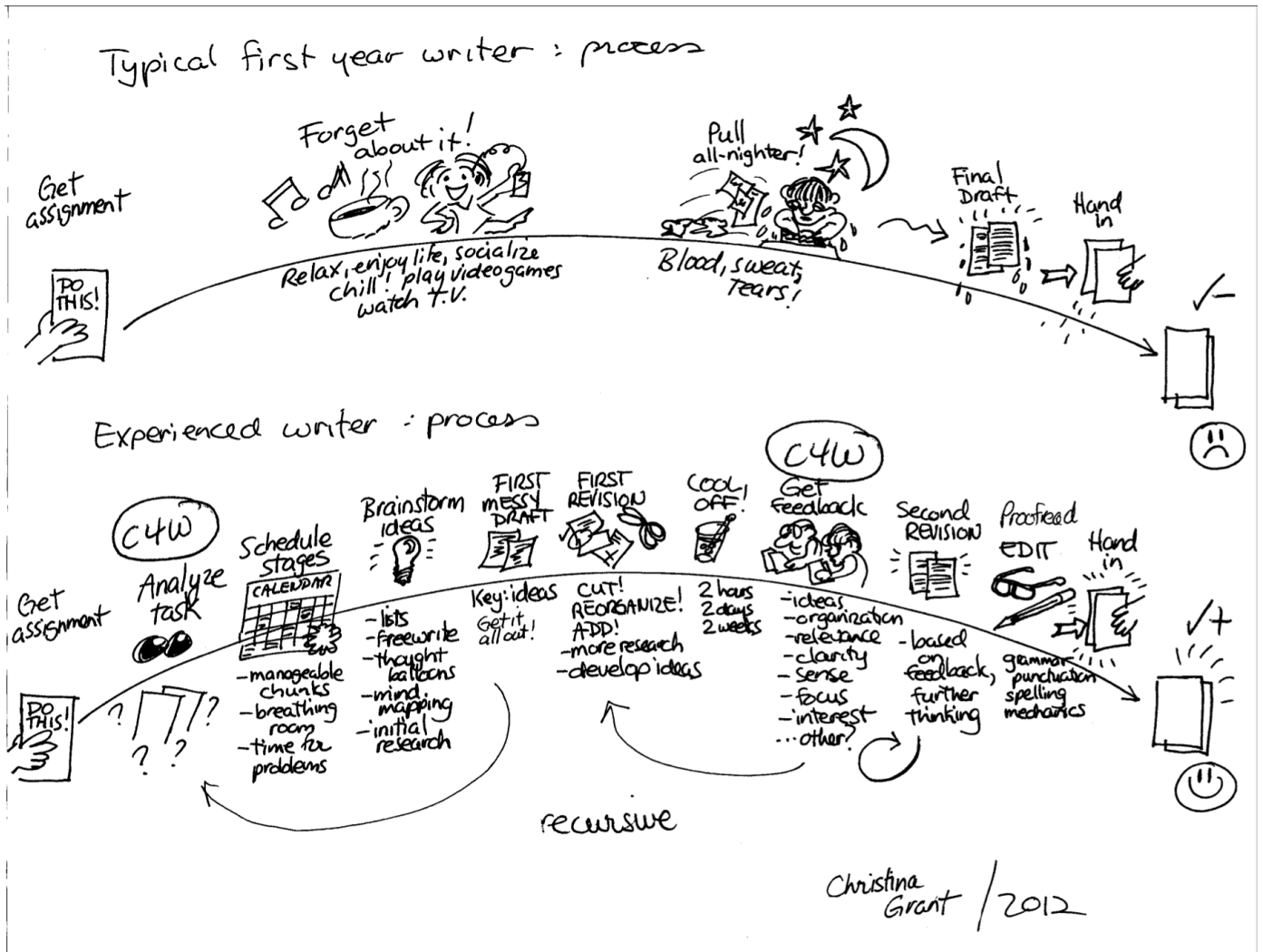
Introduction
